In a visual, physical and auditory "wake up call" to the impact of our actions on climate change, Eryc Taylor Dance (ETD) announces EARTH, a full-length collaborative dance event incorporating original choreography by ETD Artistic Director Eryc Taylor and five past recipients of the company's New Choreographer Grant, a platform offering young, aspiring NYC-based choreographers the funds needed to create and present a new dance work.

### **ETD/NCG & EARTH**

Each year, ETD awards three \$1,000 Grants to young, emerging NYC-based choreographers - otherwise known as the ETD New Choreographer Grant! These grants allow choreographers to produce a 15-20-minute new work in progress are invited to perform their individual works in process at a studio showing.

To celebrate five years of emerging choreographers, ETD has invited back Robert Mark Burke, Eryn, Aaron, Jordan and Gierre. They were chosen to create and set a new 10-15mins commissioned work for EARTH.




# **EARTH at Brooklyn Botanic Garden**

Spreading Awareness through Dance

On Tuesdays, the Brooklyn Botanic Garden (BBG) hosts Twilight Tuesdays, a special summer event at the garden. From July through September, visitors to the garden may enter at any time and stay through the evening to enjoy sunset views, summer blooms, seasonal cocktails, and special programming.

On July 16th, 2019, ETD debuted the first four works created for the EARTH series, a new collaborative seven-part dance production addressing the crisis of global climate change. The program features choreography by Robert Mark Burke, Jordan Ryder and ETD Artistic Director, Eryc Taylor. It also features original scores by composers Salomon Lerner and Daniel Tobias, EARTH was presented in site-specific performances moving throughout the Garden and was captured by **WNET ALL ARTS and Peril & Promise** for their new five part special, Climate Artists that highlights different artists and their efforts to fight climate change.
